Mid Bay Bridge Authority hosting two public informational sessions in July on new toll rate schedule

Niceville, Fla. (July 15, 2015) - The Mid-Bay Bridge Authority is hosting two informational sessions in late July where the public will have an opportunity to give input and feedback on changes to its toll rate schedule for the Mid-Bay Bridge and Spence Parkway.

Van Fuller, executive director of the Mid-Bay Bridge Authority, and the Authority's traffic engineering consultant, will give a presentation explaining the history and background of the Authority and its system, the current traffic and revenue status, the authority's broad intent for toll rates, and new toll rate options analyzed by the traffic engineering consultant.

About the Mid-Bay Bridge Authority

The Mid-Bay Bridge Authority is a dependent special District of the State located in Okaloosa County, created in 1986 by the Florida Legislature to finance, build, and oversee a bridge across Choctawhatchee Bay along with roads connecting to it. The Authority has five voting members, appointed by the Governor and the District Three Secretary of the Florida Department of

Transportation, or his/her designee, who serves as a non-voting member. An Executive Director and staff manage day-to-day administration of the Mid-Bay Bridge Authority.
