Mid-Bay Bridge Closure Update

Chipley– Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) personnel and contractors along with Mid Bay Bridge Authority are continuing to work round the clock to complete emergency repairs on the Mid-Bay Bridge (State Road 293) in Okaloosa County. FDOT is allocating statewide resources and personnel to the bridge repair.

While no time table has been established to open the Mid Bay Bridge, crews are working diligently to return traffic to the bridge as quickly as possible. FDOT's priority is to provide a safe and efficient transportation system and the current repairs are being performed to ensure the safety of the traveling public and crews working inside the Mid Bay Bridge.

FDOT also understands the inconvenience this may have caused to the citizens, businesses, schools and visitors in the area. FDOT and its workers appreciate your patience. The closure is a cautionary measure intended to minimize the stresses on the bridge during repairs and is a necessary step to quickly re-open the Mid Bay Bridge.
